



New Hotel in the Alps

MAZAGGS – Alpenhof am Achensee brings casual luxury, contemporary art and a new lifestyle to Tyrol

Golf. Art. Lifestyle. At the end of 2026, a new boutique hotel, MAZAGGS – Alpenhof am Achensee, will open in Pertisau. The concept combines personal hospitality, contemporary art, golf, cuisine and wellbeing with a contemporary understanding of luxury: high quality, but relaxed. Casual luxury instead of traditional formality.

Behind the new hotel is a building with history. The Alpenhof was built in Pertisau between 1899 and 1902 and was remodelled and extended in 1929 by Tyrolean architect Siegfried Mazagg, a representative of early modernism. After standing vacant for decades, the building was taken over in 2021 by Tyrolean entrepreneurs Hansi Entner and Dietmar "Didi" Gstrein. The historic structure and original elements are being preserved and continued with new architecture and contemporary design. The name MAZAGGS is a deliberate reference to the architect and his work on the Alpenhof.

In the historic main building, the formal language of Art Deco is reinterpreted, while the pavilion introduces a second design world with Mediterranean and Asian influences. The two areas are connected through contemporary art. Together with the dd.g collection, a curated collection of painting, sculpture and installation is being created. Changing exhibitions, a dedicated art space and an artist-in-residence programme make art a permanent part of the hotel experience.

Golf also plays a central role. Golfclub Achensee, the oldest golf club in Tyrol and a Leading Golf Course, is only a few minutes' walk away. Green fee benefits, a tee-time booking service and golf host Manfred Furtner, President of Golf in Austria, complement the offering.

Head Chef Benjamin Koidl is responsible for the culinary concept at the restaurant Siegfrieds am See. Regional products meet Mediterranean and Asian influences. Brunch, tea time, tasty bites, a bar, terrace and private dining expand the culinary offering. The restaurant is also open to external guests.

With ALMA – SPA & SPORTS, an area of around 2,000 square metres is being created for movement, treatments and regeneration. Personal training, yoga and Pilates are combined with head spa, massages, beauty treatments, saunas, a steam bath and two outdoor pools. Subject to availability, ALMA can also be used as a day spa.

MAZAGGS has 39 rooms and suites and is aimed at guests who appreciate high quality without looking for traditional luxury hospitality.
